

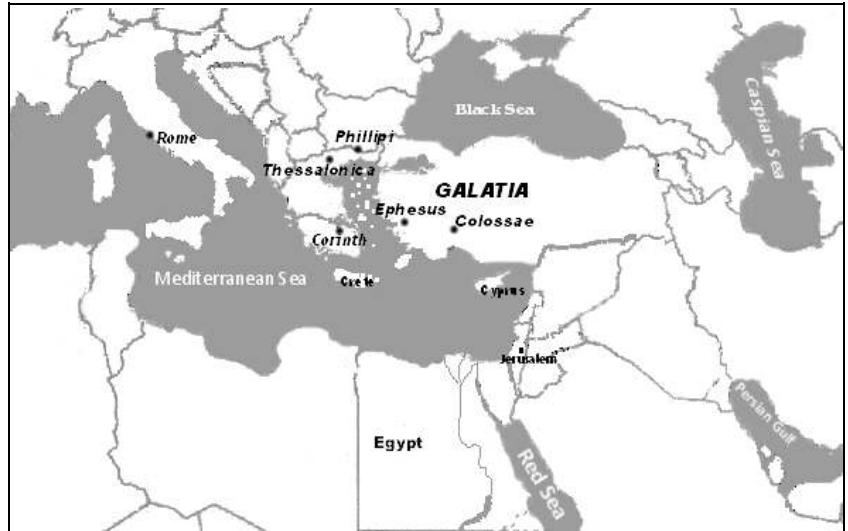

## Letter or Epistle?

Letters are not intended to be artistic, and are sent by the writer to an individual or community separated by a distance. An epistle is an artistic exercise which presents a moral lesson and is intended for publication.
